Our mission is to:

- Grow the Messianic Jewish community
- Engage the Church concerning Israel and the Jewish people

We carry out this mission through a many-faceted ministry that includes humanitarian medical and non-medical outreaches, large-scale international festivals, congregation planting and leadership training, television, print media, digital channels, and speaking engagements.



THE OUTREACH

The outreach serves as a platform for us to share the Good News of Yeshua our Messiah, with Jewish people and their neighbors. You'll serve as Yeshua's hands, feet, and heart by offering hope to these impoverished communities. We have witnessed many miraculous healings, deliverances, and salvations at these outreaches.

We achieve our mission of transforming lives both physically and spiritually, through the outreach and a Spiritual Care Team.

Depending upon the physical needs and location of the region we visit, the outreach may provide:

- A large-scale medical clinic which provides free: dental care (extractions and cleanings), cataract surgery, minor surgery, medical services (pediatrics, dermatology, gynecology, and wound care), reading glasses and an onsite pharmacy.
- A mobile medical clinic that is designed to reach remote, difficult to access communities with the same excellence in care as our large-scale medical clinic.
- Water and hygiene education and LifeStraws®, which provide clean water to families, schools, congregations, and communities.

In conjunction with the outreach, a Spiritual Care team consisting of international volunteers and local Messianic leaders provide, prayer, counseling, and proclaim the Gospel.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE TRIP COST:

- Breakfast, lunch, dinner
- Double occupancy lodging at the hotel
- Ground transportation
- Travel insurance
- Camping equipment (if applicable): cot, tent, pillow, towel

WHEN ARE PAYMENTS DUE?

- A \$250 non-refundable application fee is due when you submit your application. This is applied to the trip cost.
- Partial payments in any amount are accepted.
- The balance is due by the application closing date (see the above table)

ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS:

IS THERE A GROUP DEPARTING FROM THE US?

Yes. A JVMI representative will be traveling on the group flight from Washington Dulles to the designated city.

ARE THERE COVID-RELATED REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAVELING?

Yes, airlines require a PCR COVID test before departure as well as adherence to the protocol of the country where we will be serving.

WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR VOLUNTEERING?

- Must be a believer in Yeshua (Jesus) as Messiah
- Must have a heart to serve, easily adapt to change & welcome rugged adventure!
- Your Pastor/ Rabbi must complete and submit a recommendation form for you
- An online application must be completed and submitted
- Must be able to:
 - Climb 4 flights of stairs easily, stand for at least one hour with no breaks, and be able to walk at least one mile at a moderate pace without assistance
 - Handle high elevations and third world conditions
 - Travel in a vehicle on unpaved, bumpy and dusty roads for up to 8 hours
- New applicants must also complete a phone interview

ARE VACCINATIONS AND MALARIA MEDICINE REQUIRED?

JVMI does not require vaccinations; however, the Center for Disease Control (CDC) suggests vaccinations and malaria medicine for some areas in Ethiopia and Zimbabwe. Please check with your physician or a travel clinic. To have the most benefit, see a health-care provider at least 4–6 weeks before your trip.

WHAT CREDENTIALS ARE REQUIRED FOR MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS?
